She published more than 150 peer reviewed papers, several book chapters, and edited two radiotherapy books published by Springer. The last book is specialized for breast radiation therapy and was published in 2022. Her team is part of CINDERELLA project, that was granted a competitive grant by Horizon 2021, and in 2022 she received the ICRF-ASCO career development award for a breast-MRI artificial intelligence project.
